



## **All-In-One Interferon Testing**

Using the MILLIPLEX<sup>®</sup> Human Interferon Multiplex Panel

Interferons (IFNs) are widely expressed cytokines that have potent antiviral and antiproliferative effects. These cytokines are the first line of defense against viral infections and have important roles in immunosurveillance for malignant cells. Functionally, type I and type III IFNs are induced during viral infection and involved in host defense against viruses. IFN<sub>Y</sub> is involved primarily in the allergic response, in host defense against intracellular pathogens, and in control of tumor growth. Studies of IFNs have broadened the mechanistic understanding of cell signaling, gene transcription, and innate and acquired immunity.

The **MILLIPLEX**<sup>®</sup> Human Interferon Panel (Cat. No. HIFN-130K) is a 9-plex kit to be used for the simultaneous quantification of the following analytes in serum or plasma samples and tissue/cell lysate and culture supernatant samples: IFNa2, IFN $\beta$ , IFN $\epsilon$ , IFN $\omega$ , IFN $\gamma$  Receptor 1 (IFNGR1), IFN $\gamma$ , IL-29/IFN $\lambda$ 1, IL-28A/ IFN $\lambda$ 2, and IL-28B/IFN $\lambda$ 3.





Figure 1. Interferon targets included in the MILLIPLEX  $^{\odot}$  Human Interferon panel (Cat. No. HIFN-130K).
